Facility and Inmate Information

- The facility serves as a low-security correctional center for 262 adult male offenders.
- The 38-acre complex opened in 1988 and includes 52 buildings, offender housing and limited staff residences.
- Security measures include 12-foot cyclone fencing topped with razor wire, magnetic locking gates, closed-circuit television and public address systems.
- The maximum offender stay is 18 months, and the average stay is six months.
- Community service is provided in the local area and California State University Fullerton, additionally offenders routinely participate in the annual Barstow Rodeo benefit.
- When necessary, the City of Baker Fire Engine 53 is assisted by offender crews who are trained in fire fighting and victim rescue.
- Dining, laundry and medical services are provided along with recreational and physical activity opportunities.

Programs

The following voluntary programs and services help prepare offenders to return to their local communities and provide for their well being while at the facility.

- Educational offerings include GED, Adult Basic Education (ABE), English as a Second Language (ESL) and computer training and lab.
- Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) and Narcotics Anonymous (NA) offer substance abuse and addiction counseling.
- Moral Reconciliation Therapy, a voluntary self-paced 16-step program, enables offenders to gain self-esteem, set goals, improve life skills, think positively and evaluate their moral reasoning
- Anger Management and Parenting Wisely classes are offered to offenders participating in MRT.
- All offenders participate in the Inmate Work Training Incentive program in one of three areas: support services, community work or academic assistance.
- The Career Development Program provides training in employment skills and techniques, communication skills, money management, community resources, family and social interactions and parole resources.

Location

The Baker Correctional Facility, located in Baker, California, is approximately 170 miles northeast of Los Angeles between Barstow, California, and Las Vegas, Nevada.
